Donation Drive Ideas

New Items

Feed our Families: Canned goods, sugar, rice, non-perishable food

Home Sweet Home: Twin sheet sets, pillows, towels, blankets

Family Meal Time: Pots, pans, plastic dishware, plastic utensils, mixing bowls, measuring cups

Clean Sweep: Sponges, mops, brooms, dish soap, laundry detergent, bleach

Shower our Babies with Love: Bottles, clothes, diapers, wipes, formula, baby food, playpens, bibs, baby blankets, sippy cups, pacifier

Goodies for Kids: Stickers, coloring books, crayons, notebooks, teen books, arts and craft kits, bookbags

Gently-Used Items

Dress for Success: Professional clothing for men and women, dresses, suits, slacks, shirts

Walk in their Shoes: Women's, men's, and children's shoes

Accessorize: Purses, watches, jewelry, scarves, belts, hats, ties, wallets
