The Hal Herman Children's Fund

The Hal Herman Children's Fund at Women In Distress (WID) was established by Hal and Lois Herman to help children who live in a domestic violence environment. Through the Fund and generosity of supporters like you, the smallest survivors of domestic violence receive the support they need.

Even when children don't see domestic abuse, they usually know it's happening. When children see, hear and experience violence, it affects them in lifelong ways. These children are more likely to exhibit behavioral issues and physical health problems, including depression, anxiety, and violence toward peers.

Counseling

WID provides counseling to children at the shelter and the Family Center. We offer children's groups, individual counseling, and parenting classes. Rapport building, anger management, play sessions, and counseling games are some of the tools WID uses to help children who have experienced domestic violence. **WID's innovative early Child Therapy Program** is making an

impact in reducing the effects of witnessing domestic violence and helping children break the cycle of abuse. While participants receive services, their children are entertained in a child friendly, safe environment which WID refers to as Respite, so their parent can get the help they need while being cared for.

More than 50% of women who are victims of domestic violence live in households with children under 12 years old

Year Round Activities

WID also support the children with year round activities to keep their minds busy, and their hearts more full. Often WID is visited by community members and organizations that donate their time and services, like petting zoos and magicians. **This year will be the Inaugural Children's Week Celebration, where our kiddos are taken off campus**

and busy doing fun things and learning! Domestic violence doesn't discriminate, or stop when life gets busy, that's why here at WID we have three big annual drives focused on getting the children ready for school with our Joanne DeLizza Back to School Memorial Drive, and we make sure their tummy's are full with our Thanksgiving drive, and that their stockings are stuffed with our Holiday Toy Drive.



Hal and I have a special heart for children. We see every time we visit the campus of Women In Distress what great work they do with children. We're so committed to raising support for the Children's Fund that all of our friends and family know that there is no greater honor to us than for them to support the Children's Fund.
